**Biographical Sketch:** A veteran of the Second World War, William J. Yost completed his secondary school education in Kitchener in 1947. He entered the University of Western Ontario and received his Bachelor of Science degree in 1951. He had been commissioned as a lieutenant in 1950 in the Royal Canadian Ordnance Corps. He served in the UN Observer Group in Lebanon in 1958 and with the United Nations Emergency Force in the Middle East. He attended the Canadian Army Staff College, 1959-1961 and, in 1962, went to Ghana as a member of the Canadian Armed Forces Training team.

Language: textual material in the fond is in English.

**Scope and Content:** Most of the papers relate to courses taken by General Yost, visits and exercises.

**Arrangement:** This finding aid has been arranged numerically by file number. Accession numbers are included where known. All information can be found in files 58D 1 5.1 through 58D 1 10.17, inclusive.
